



Hello Cedar Point Resort and Campground Friends and Family,

Mike and I hope you are all safe and healthy! We are getting a lot of questions and wanted to communicate where we are at with what we know today. We will keep our website up to date with current information and as always don't hesitate to reach out with questions.

Currently Minnesota is under a stay at home order until 5/4 however lodging is considered an essential business which allow us to remain open. We support the governor and our legislators in their efforts to protect all citizens safety and wellbeing. We hope the stay at home order with some contingencies, will be lifted to allow for the fishing opener and beginning of the tourism season to take place in Minnesota. As of 4/15/2020, the Minnesota governor has expanded the list of essential workers many of whom support the resort business.

With this we are continuing to prepare as usual to open Cedar Point Resort as planned and are looking forward to welcoming you for your stay with us. This season will bring some necessary changes surrounding reducing or eliminating the potential spread of the virus. We continue to monitor as the circumstances warrant.

Some Items We Do Know At This Point

- We need an additional 24 hours between guests to clean cabins this season. When arriving to Cedar Point Resort guest will not "check in" at the lodge as you have done in prior years. You can go directly to your cabins. We will be sure your cabin has all the necessary paperwork and arrange for pick up once you are comfortable and settled.
- Check in times will be staggered, Mike and Tracy will call you 1 week prior to your vacation to discuss check in as well as answer any additional questions you may have.
- In order to accommodate for an additional 24 hours to clean, we are asking our guest to depart 1 day earlier. If you arrive on Saturday, you will depart on Friday by noon and if you arrive on Friday, you will depart Thursday at noon. We are following Minnesota resort community guidelines as many resorts are following the same structure for the 2020 season.
 - Cedar Point Resort cabins are based on a daily rate however after on the 5th day the weekly rate is applied. For your safety, deeper cleaning and to assist in reducing the spread of COVID we are making this change for the 2020 vacation season.
- The extra day will allow for our cleaning crew to deep clean cabins and complete a UV light treatment. We will provide all cabins with cleaning supplies to help you feel more comfortable with cleaning while on vacation with us. If you would like to bring your own cleaning supplies, you are welcome to.
- The campground shower will be closed however we will open it on a case by case basis.
- Kayaks and paddle boards will be available and can be checked out daily. We will take the time to sanitize equipment for guest use.

- We are requesting trash to be placed in a proper garbage bag (not grocery bag) that can be sealed/tied once filled. We will have additional garbage bags for you, should you run out.
- We do not have recycling this year and have provided can crushers in each cabin. Please crush each can (up to 16oz) to help reduce space in the garbage container. We will continue to source a recycling company and you are encouraged to pack your recycling upon departure and take to your local recycling.
- The playground will remain open however we will not be responsible for cleaning after every child uses the playground. We struggled with this decision as the playground is something kids really look forward to using at Cedar Point Resort. Please wipe down the high touch areas your child uses.
- The state of Minnesota has closed all public pools therefore we must follow state guidelines and close Cedar Point Resort pool. We will plan to open if the guidelines change. The arcade will also remain close as it does not allow for social distancing among groups. We can open by appointment only.

New “fun” this year at Cedar Point Resort and Campground

- We are very excited to bring outside BINGO this year. Win exciting prizes 😊
- 2 new fire pits will be added in effort to bring campfire enjoyment while practicing “social distancing”.
- Smores and roasted donuts will be provided to each cabin to use at the firepit(s), upon request.
- Yoga will be available, upon request.
- Cinnamon rolls can be ordered on Wednesday evenings and delivered to your cabin on Thursday mornings.
- Pizza, ice cream and other food items can also be ordered. We are still working out details around how this will be accomplished.
- We are currently building an online apparel store on our newly designed website. We hope to have it ready for you very soon.

Cedar Point Resort will do everything possible to make your stay safe and enjoyable, ultimately you are responsible for your own personal safety. Please remain aware of distancing requirements (at the time of your vacation). The good news is our resort provides for excellent distance between cabins and our entire 15 acres of land. Families and friends can rent a cabin separate from other cabins, the outdoor areas are large enough to allow guest’s to sit at the campfire or picnic table and be physically distant from their neighbor. Plus, fishing on North Star lake is distancing at its BEST! On behalf of the Boldt Family, we truly appreciate your flexibility with the new structure for the 2020 vacation season.
