Weekly rentals

- Saturday arrivals: depart by noon on the following Friday.
- o Friday arrivals: depart by noon on the following Thursday.

• Non weekly rentals and shoulder season weekly rentals:

- If there is no one booked the day of your departure date, we will discuss the departure day with you and the departure time will be by 9:00am.
- Remember, Cedar Point Resort cabins are based on a daily rate however after on the 5th day the weekly (reduced) rate is applied, there is no refund for the changes.
- Cedar Point Resort guest will continue to "check in" at the cabin you have rented. Upon arrival, you can go directly to your cabins and bypass the traditional lodge check in. We will be sure your cabin has all the necessary paperwork and arrange for pick up once you are comfortable and settled. We really enjoyed taking the time to talk with you all individually after you arrive to your cabin.
- Check in times will remain staggered, you will receive an email approximately 1 week prior to
 your vacation with your check in time. We are able to offer earlier check in times and will let
 you know your time and we will do our best to flex your check in time to accommodate with
 your family and/or friends in mind.
- We will continue to provide cabins with some cleaning supplies to help you feel more comfortable with cleaning while on vacation with us. If you would like to bring your own cleaning supplies, you are welcome to.
